

Changes to Mercury-Added Lamp Disposal in California

- * CA Department of Toxic Substances Control is finalizing new regulations covering mercury bearing wastes, which include all mercury added lamps (MAL's.)
- * After February 2004, all spent MAL's will become state listed hazardous wastes, with no exceptions for any lamp type, mercury content, testing protocol or purchase date.
 - This includes all SYLVANIA ECOLOGIC®, GE ECOLUX® and PHILIPS ALTO® lamps.
- * After February 2006, no MAL's may be disposed of as solid waste.

- No exceptions for any lamp type or class of user.
