

Recycling of Mercury-Added Lamps

- * California is joining several other states* that ban all spent MALs from solid waste and encourage lamp recycling.
- * In California, MALs that are recycled qualify for simplified handling as Universal Wastes; otherwise, they must be handled as full hazardous wastes.
- * The NEMA Lamp Manufacturers maintain a website at www.lamprecycle.org which lists lamp recyclers. Links to all state lamp disposal requirements are included.
- * A summary of future MAL disposal options in California is shown in the next slide.
